

DIRECT SCHOOL ADMISSION (DSA)

LLP (Music) / ALP (Sports & Health Science)

FOR ADMISSION TO SECONDARY ONE IN 2020

CRITERIA

Male students from primary schools completing their PSLE examinations in academic year 2019, who meet the following criteria, are invited to apply for Direct School Admission to St. Patrick's School:

Area of Interest	Minimum criteria
Band (Concert, brass or marching)	A current member of the school band / guitar ensemble with some playing experience with relevant instrument/s.
Guitar Ensemble	or Attainment of an ABRSM grade (Theory and/or practical) or equivalent on a musical instrument.
Football	Represented School/Club/Academy in any tournaments or any local / overseas competitions.
Athletics	Participated in National Inter School Championships or any local / overseas competitions, or Be able to demonstrate talent / attributes in athletics.
Badminton	Participated in National / Zonal Inter School Championships or any local / overseas competitions, or
Basketball	Be able to demonstrate talent / attributes in badminton / basketball.
Tennis	Participated in National Inter School Championships. or Participated in tournaments organised by SPEX, Intermediate or KLM.
Squash	Participated in Squash Junior League or Represented School / Club for National Inter School Championships or SSRA Tournaments
Golf	Minimum USGA Handicap Index of not more than 24.0 (as of 1 st April 2016) from a bona fide club affiliated to a recognized golf association
Cricket	Represented School / Club in SCA competitions or equivalent.

- * For students not studying in MOE schools, applicants are to obtain a DSA Registration (RG) number at MOE Customer Service Centre.
- * All international students are to take part in the Admissions Exercise for International Students (AEIS) before applying. International students who do not meet the AEIS requirement will not be considered for the DSA-Sec allocation exercise.

Students who are admitted through DSA – LLP (Music) / ALP (Sports & Health Science), will be expected to remain and honour his commitment to the DSA School that he is posted to, for the duration of the programme that he has applied for and been admitted into.

Selection Criteria

Audition & Panel Interview

For LLP (Music):

1. Applicants are required to play a piece of their choice on their instrument. Applicants will also be given a separate piece to sight-read followed by a short listening test.
2. Applicants are to bring their own instruments for the audition. Only percussion instruments and piano will be provided for audition.
3. Shortlisted applicants will be invited for an interview on a separate date.

For ALP (Sports & Health Science):

1. Applicants are required to attend a trial for the respective sports.
(Trial dates will be notified on school website by 1st July 2019)
 2. Only shortlisted applicants will be invited for additional trials and/or interview.
 3. Applicants are to bring their own personal sporting equipment or gear for the trials.
- *All applicants will be required to declare any medical status at the start of their trials / auditions.*
